SFP transceiver made by any manufacturer can be used as long as it meets the industry SFP standard and supports data transfer rates of 100 Mbit/s or 1 Gbit/s. Plug the SFP module into the router's SFP port for fibre optic connectivity. No additional settings need to be made. An optical module is an optoelectronic conversion device that transmits data by converting electrical signals into optical signals. Cisco introduces GPON with the Catalyst GPON platform.
