Key Components

1. Fiber Cable

- o OS2 single-mode cables are recommended for 10G networks.
 - o Available in indoor, outdoor, or hybrid versions depending on installation needs.
 - o Can be customized in length and jacket type for wall, attic, or direct-burial runs .
- ### 2. SFP+ Transceivers

- ### 3. Fiber Jumpers and Patch Cords
- o Pre-terminated LC/SC/ST/FC connectors reduce installation errors and insertion loss.
 - o Available in various lengths to connect switches, media converters, or patch panels .
- ### 4. Fiber Enclosures and Management
- o Wall-mounted or rack-mounted enclosures help organize fiber runs and protect connectors.
 - o PLC splitters can be used if distributing fiber to multiple endpoints in FTTH-style setups .

Deployment Tips

- o Plan your fiber routes carefully, using existing conduits or installing riser-rated indoor cables for vertical runs.
- o Test optical link budgets to ensure sufficient signal strength, especially for longer runs or BiDi modules.



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- o Use high-quality connectors and patch cords to minimize insertion loss and maintain 10G performance.
- o Consider future-proofing by installing extra conduits or spare fibers for potential network expansion .
