100BASE-FX SFP Overview

A 100BASE-FX SFP is a small form-factor pluggable transceiver that enables 100Mbps Fast Ethernet transmission over multimode fiber, typically at a 1310nm wavelength, with distances up to 2 km depending on fiber type and link budget . It converts electrical signals from the switch into optical signals for fiber transmission and vice versa, allowing flexible deployment in switches, routers, or media converters . These modules are hot-swappable, meaning the switch does not need to reboot when installing or replacing them .

Compatibility with Gigabit Switches

Many modern Gigabit switches support dual-rate ports, which can operate at either 100Mbps or 1Gbps depending on the SFP module installed . By inserting a 100BASE-FX SFP into a Gigabit port, the switch will automatically negotiate a 100Mbps link speed with the connected fiber device. This allows legacy 100Mbps fiber infrastructure to coexist with higher-speed Gigabit networks without requiring a full upgrade of all fiber links.

Fiber Cabling Considerations

- o Fiber Type: Use multimode fiber (MMF) for 100BASE-FX links, typically OM1 or OM2 for distances up to 2 km .
- o Connectors: LC connectors are standard for 100BASE-FX SFPs and provide reliable, low-loss connections .
- o Pre-terminated Cables: Using factory-terminated fiber cables reduces installation errors and ensures proper alignment and low insertion loss .
- o Topology: Star topology is recommended for connecting multiple switches, as it centralizes traffic through a main switch and reduces collisions .

Deployment Tips

- o Check SFP Compatibility: Ensure the 100BASE-FX SFP is supported by your Gigabit switch model. Cisco and other vendors provide modules certified for dual-rate operation .
- o Distance and Link Budget: Verify that the fiber length does not exceed the SFP's maximum supported distance (typically 2 km for multimode fiber) to maintain signal integrity .
- o Full-Duplex Operation: Configure the switch ports for full-duplex to maximize throughput and reduce collisions.
- o Monitoring and Testing: Use pre-terminated cables and test the link with optical power meters or switch
