The 2024 National Standard for Cable Trays is defined by NEMA BI-50016, which provides comprehensive installation, handling, and maintenance guidelines for cable tray systems.

Overview of NEMA BI-50016-2024

NEMA BI-50016-2024, formerly known as VE2, is the current standard for cable tray installation in the United States. It addresses the shipping, handling, storing, and installation of cable tray systems, including both metal and nonmetallic types, and provides guidance on maintenance and system modifications . This standard ensures that cable tray systems are installed safely and efficiently in accordance with the National Electrical Code (NEC) and harmonized with the Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) where applicable .

Scope and Coverage

- o Metal Cable Trays (NEMA VE1): Covers ladder, ventilated, solid bottom, single-rail, wire mesh, and trough-type trays. It specifies manufacturing requirements, load/span class designations, grounding, and connection methods .
- o Nonmetallic Cable Trays (NEMA FG-1): Specifies requirements for fiberglass or other nonmetallic trays, including ladder, ventilated, solid bottom, and channel types, ensuring compliance with NEC and UL 568 performance standards .
- o Installation Guidelines: BI-50016 provides detailed instructions for proper installation, including support spacing, alignment, and securing of trays to prevent mechanical stress or damage .
- o Maintenance and Modifications: Offers guidance on system inspection, repair, and modifications, ensuring long-term reliability and safety .
