

Active Optical Devices LPO Cleared for Customs in India

Article Overview

Active Optical Devices (LPO) can be imported into India if they comply with BIS registration, labeling requirements, and customs documentation, with applicable duties under Chapter 90 of the Customs Tariff.

Regulatory Requirements

Active Optical Devices fall under electronics and optical instruments, which are regulated under the Electronics and IT Goods (Requirements of Compulsory Registration) Order, 2021. Import of such devices is prohibited unless they are registered with the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) and comply with labeling requirements, or if a specific exemption letter from MeitY is obtained for a particular consignment . Non-compliant goods reaching Indian ports must be re-exported or destroyed under customs supervision.

Customs Clearance Process

To clear LPO devices through Indian customs, the following steps are essential:

- o Obtain Importer-Exporter Code (IEC): Mandatory for all importers, issued by the Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT), .
- o Pre-Arrival Documentation: Prepare the Bill of Entry (BOE) electronically via the ICEGATE portal, including shipment details, HS code classification, value, and origin .
- o Customs Assessment: Customs officials verify documentation, assess duties, and may conduct a physical inspection if required .
- o Duty Payment: Applicable duties include Basic Customs Duty, Integrated GST, and compensation cess, depending on the classification under Chapter 90 - Optical, Photographic, Cinematographic, Measuring, Checking, Precision Instruments .
- o Supporting Documents: Include Certificate of Origin, insurance certificate, and payment terms (e.g., Letter of Credit) as needed .

Import Duty Classification

Active Optical Devices are generally classified under Chapter 90 of the Customs Tariff, which covers optical, photographic, cinematographic, measuring, and checking instruments. Duties vary based on the specific device type, whether it is active or passive, and its intended use .

Compliance Tips

- o Ensure BIS registration and labeling compliance before shipment.
- o Maintain all customs documentation for inspection.

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- o Engage a licensed Customs House Agent (CHA) to facilitate smooth clearance.
- o Verify if any special exemptions from MeitY apply for your consignment to avoid delays. By following these steps and ensuring regulatory compliance, Active Optical Devices can be legally imported and cleared through Indian customs without unnecessary delays .
