By convention, to avoid any misunderstanding and to simplify the cable tray design and installation, the bending radius for all cable trays and conduits should be at least 300 mm for Low Voltage, Sensitive

Drilling Holes for splice plates must be drilled in field-cut cable trays. The most common method of locating the hole positions is to use a splice plate as a template.

Cable tray systems are to be installed so they are accessible. If possible 300mm minimum should be left above or between installed systems to allow for cable

Splices are permitted in a cable tray if the splice is accessible and insulated by a method approved by the authority having jurisdiction. Splices can project above the side rails of the cable

Cable splices can be placed within a cable tray if they are made and insulated using approved techniques and



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are easily accessible. Additionally, splices are allowed to extend above the side rails

Although no multiplying effect is assumed at bends in tray installations, an increase in tension is sometimes necessary to account for the force required to bend the cable around the sheave.
