FC Connector

The FC (Ferrule Connector) is designed for high-precision or high-vibration environments, such as industrial, railway, or aviation networks. It has a round metal body with a threaded coupling, which ensures a secure connection that resists vibration and accidental disconnection. Like SC, FC connectors also use a 2.5 mm ferrule, but the screw-threaded design provides higher mechanical stability. FC connectors are commonly used in telecom systems, optical distribution frames, and long-haul networks where reliability under stress is critical .
