Material and Construction

The trays are lightweight yet high-strength, capable of supporting heavy cable loads while remaining easy to handle and install.

- o Provides ventilation and heat dissipation for cables.

o Channel/Perforated Type FRP Cable Tray:

- o Features a perforated bottom with integral side rails.
- o Often used in fire-proof, moisture-proof, dust-proof, and anti-interference applications.
- o Can be supplied with flat or peaked covers for additional protection against dust, liquids, or snow accumulation.
