- o Wall-Mount Boxes: Compact enclosures for indoor use, often in network rooms or IDF closets, supporting LC, SC, or MPO/MTP connectors .
- o Splice Boxes / Splice Enclosures: Designed for splicing fibers and storing excess cable length, often with removable splice cassettes for easy access .
- o Patch Panels: Rack-mounted units that provide high-density connections for multiple fibers, ideal for data centers and telecom networks . Materials can be plastic (lightweight, cost-effective) or metal (durable, industrial-grade), depending on environmental and security requirements .

Compatibility and Connectors

Fiber boxes support both single-mode and multi-mode fibers. Common connector types include LC, SC, ST, E2000, and MTP/MPO, with different polishing finishes like UPC (flat) or APC (angled) to reduce signal reflection . The choice of connector and fiber type depends on network distance, bandwidth requirements, and equipment compatibility.
