

Cable fastener installed on cable tray

The fittings can be fastened to the cable tray rail either with double clamps of type DOP A2 or with truss-head bolts of type FRS and combination nuts. The exceptions to this are vertical bends, adjustable bend elements and fittings with a side height of 35 mm. These fittings can only, when completely installed, without damage either to conductors or structural system use maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is subjected the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. Cable or "P" clamps and plastic tie wraps are used to fasten cables/conductors to the ladder tray. Single conductors must be fastened to prevent excessive movement generated by fault current magnetic
