Classification Overview

o Construction in Progress (CIP)

o If cable trays are installed as part of a larger construction project, their cost may initially be recorded in a CIP account and later transferred to the appropriate fixed asset category once the project is completed .

Considerations for Asset Management

o Capitalization Threshold: Only cable trays exceeding the company's capitalization limit should be recorded as fixed assets; smaller or low-cost trays may be expensed immediately .

o Depreciation: Once classified as a fixed asset, cable trays are depreciated over their useful life, typically aligned with the building or electrical system they support.

o Standards Compliance: Cable trays must meet local and international standards (e.g., BS EN 61537, NEMA, ISO/IEC 11801-1) to ensure safety and durability, which can affect their valuation and classification .
