Standard Horizontal Tee Options

A reducing tee has a smaller branch width, while an expanding tee has a larger branch width, enabling smooth integration with different tray sizes . **45-Degree Wye Fittings:** For smoother cable transitions and reduced bending stress, horizontal wye fittings provide a 45-degree branch, which is ideal for high-density or sensitive cable installations .

Angle-Type and Custom Tees

Angle-Type Perforated Tees: These specialized fittings allow branching at non-standard angles beyond 90° or 45°, offering flexibility for complex cable tray networks. They feature perforated bases for ventilation and easy cable securing, and often include short straight extensions at connection points for secure splicing . **Material and Finish Options:** Horizontal tees are available in hot-dip galvanized steel, stainless steel, or powder-coated finishes to meet industrial standards and ensure long-term durability .

Installation Considerations

- o Ensure compatibility with the cable tray class (e.g., NEMA Classes 12B, 20A, 20C) and side rail dimensions .
- o Maintain proper support and alignment to prevent sagging or excessive stress on cables.
- o Use perforated or ventilated designs to allow airflow and prevent heat buildup in high-density installations .
- o For custom angles, angle-type tees or wye fittings are recommended to reduce bending stress and maintain cable integrity . By selecting the appropriate horizontal tee--standard, reducing, expanding, or angle-type--you can achieve efficient cable routing at any required angle while ensuring mechanical strength, ventilation, and compliance with industrial standards.
