

Cable trays facing upwards along the wall

Cable trays can be securely mounted against a wall with the open side facing upwards using wall brackets, supports, and careful alignment to ensure stability and compliance with standards.

Mounting Techniques

To install a cable tray flat against a wall with the open side facing upwards, use wall supports or brackets designed for the tray type. For example, RVK wall supports are commonly used for KR-type trays, allowing the tray to rest on the bracket's tip while the opposite edge is pressed into place from below, ensuring a neat and stable installation . Brackets or hangers should be spaced according to the tray manufacturer's recommendations to prevent sagging or deformation.

Handling Fittings and Tray Alignment

When adding fittings or extending the tray, automatic alignment features in some software or pre-fabricated trays may cause the tray to revert to its default orientation (open side facing up). To avoid this, manually place fittings and use workplane-based adjustments to maintain the desired orientation . This ensures that elbows, tees, and other connectors align properly with the wall-mounted tray.

Material and Safety Considerations

Select tray materials suitable for the environment: painted or galvanized steel for indoor use, stainless steel or aluminum for corrosive or high-humidity areas . Ensure mechanical strength is sufficient to support the full cable load and maintain proper spacing to allow heat dissipation. Perforated or wire mesh trays improve airflow and reduce heat accumulation . Always follow standards such as BS EN 61537 for cable tray systems to ensure safety and reliability .

Installation Best Practices

- o Inspect all materials before installation to confirm compliance with approved specifications .
 - o Maintain a straight and level alignment along the wall to prevent stress on cables.
 - o Use fire-rated penetration seals if trays pass through walls or floors .
 - o Periodically inspect trays for corrosion, mechanical damage, or loose connections to ensure long-term reliability .
- By following these guidelines, a wall-mounted cable tray with the open side facing upwards can be installed safely, securely, and in compliance with industry standards, while allowing easy cable management and maintenance.
