When connecting a cable from one distribution box to another, use a cable with at least the same gauge as the incoming supply, include an external fuse, and follow proper safety and installation standards.

Cable Selection and Gauge

The cable connecting two distribution boxes should match or exceed the gauge of the incoming supply cable to ensure safe current handling and prevent overheating or voltage drop. For typical installations, the maximum recommended cable cross-section is 10 mm², but this depends on the load and distance between boxes. Always verify the current rating and insulation type suitable for the environment (indoor, outdoor, or industrial).

Safety Measures

- o External Fuse: Install a fuse before the second distribution box to protect the cable and downstream circuits from overloads or short circuits.
- o Power Off: Ensure the main supply is switched off before connecting or disconnecting cables to prevent electric shock.
- o Grounding: Properly ground both distribution boxes to reduce the risk of electrical hazards.

Installation Guidelines

- o Connection Points: Use screw terminals or approved connectors inside the distribution boxes for secure connections.
- o Cable Routing: Keep cables organized, avoid sharp bends, and protect them from mechanical damage. Use conduits or cable trays where necessary.

- o Label all connections and circuits for easier maintenance and troubleshooting.
- o Schedule regular inspections to ensure connections remain secure and the cable insulation is intact. By adhering to these guidelines, the connection between distribution boxes will be safe, reliable, and compliant with electrical standards, ensuring stable power distribution across circuits.
