They are required to be used on locations where the tray is not continuously grounded or when splice plates that aren't UL listed are used.

TC cables are rated for 600 volts and can be used in industrial power or control circuits, where flame retardant cables are desired. Allowed installations include

Cables must be secured to the cable tray prior to and after the transition, and protected by guarding or location. The electrical connection between sections can be maintained with bonding jumpers or a

SOLID-BOTTOM CABLE TRAY Providing additional cable protection, solid-bottom cable tray is sometimes preferred to support and protect numerous small instrumentation and control cables.

I would say no, you must size the bonding jumper for the cable tray according to the highest rated OCPD likely to energize the tray. So if you have a 30A circuit in the tray, a #10 EGC
