

Can I connect to a power supply box if it's out of power

Article Overview

You can restore power to a power supply box by either using a UPS for backup power or safely jumping the power-on signal for an ATX PSU.

For a Computer ATX Power Supply

If your ATX power supply is not connected to a motherboard, it cannot turn on by itself. You can safely power it on using the following method:

- o **Safety First:** Ensure the PSU is unplugged from the wall and switched off. Capacitors inside can store dangerous voltage .
- o **Locate the Power-On Pin:** On the 24-pin ATX connector, the green wire (pin #14) is the "power on" line, and black wires are ground .
- o **Jump the Green to Ground:** Use a short piece of wire to connect the green wire to any black wire. This simulates pressing the power button on a motherboard .
- o **Power On:** Plug the PSU into the wall and switch it on. The PSU should now provide power to connected devices.
- o **Optional Switch Setup:** For repeated use, you can solder a toggle switch between the green and black wires for safer and more convenient control .

For Home or Office Backup Power (UPS or Generator)

If your power supply box refers to a UPS or backup system:

- o **Select the Right UPS:** Ensure the UPS capacity exceeds your total device load by 20-30% .
- o **Initial Charging:** Plug the UPS into a wall outlet and charge the battery for 8-12 hours before connecting devices .
- o **Connect Devices:** Use battery-backed outlets for critical devices (computers, networking equipment) and surge-only outlets for non-essential devices .
- o **Power On:** Press and hold the UPS power button to activate it. The UPS will now supply power during outages .
- o **Manual Transfer Switch (Optional):** For whole-house backup, a manual transfer switch allows safe switching between utility power and a generator. Turn off the main breaker, connect the utility, generator, and panel wires according to the manufacturer's instructions, then test the switch .

Safety Tips

- o **Never attempt to power a PSU or UPS without understanding the wiring;** incorrect connections can cause electric shock or equipment damage .
