

Can a secondary distribution box be fitted with a socket

Article Overview

Yes, a secondary distribution box can be fitted with a socket, provided it is installed correctly with appropriate protection and wiring according to electrical regulations.

Key Considerations

- o The supply cable from the main consumer unit to the secondary box must be adequately rated for the total load, considering the number of sockets and appliances .

Installation Guidelines

- o Install the secondary box in a dry, accessible location with proper ventilation and at a suitable height (typically around 1.5 meters), .
- o Ensure earthing arrangements are correct, especially for outbuildings, to prevent electric shock .
- o Label all circuits clearly and avoid exceeding the maximum load of the secondary box or supply cable .
- o For outdoor or shed installations, follow Part P of the Building Regulations and use a qualified electrician for certification .

Practical Example

In a shed, a secondary consumer unit can feed:

- o A 6A lighting circuit
- o A 16A socket circuit Both circuits are protected by their own RCBOs, allowing safe use of power tools and other appliances without overloading the supply .
