

Can an electricity meter be connected to a distribution box

- o The distribution box should have adequate space for the meter and circuit breakers, with a recommended 20% extra space for future expansion .



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- o Circuit breakers should match the rated current of the incoming supply and the meter's specifications to prevent overloads .
- o After installation, perform final testing to ensure the meter and distribution box function correctly and safely .
