

Can fiber optic cables be straightened

Fiber optic cables can be straightened using controlled heat methods, such as hot water immersion for small-scale fibers or stress-relief heating for industrial MCVD tubes.

DIY and Small-Scale Methods

Hot Water and Aluminum Tube Method: Fiber optic cables often come wound on reels, which can leave them naturally curved. A safe and effective way to straighten them is to insert the fibers into aluminum tubes with an internal diameter similar to the fiber, then immerse the assembly in nearly boiling water for about 10 seconds. Afterward, immediately place the tubes in cold water. This process relaxes the fiber's bends, leaving it straight and easier to install in projects like building lighting or model layouts . **Rod or Tube Insertion:** Another simple method is to insert the fiber into a rigid rod, such as a plastic coffee stirrer. This keeps the fiber straight when positioning it vertically or threading it through small openings . **Hot Air Gun Method:** Some users employ a hot air gun to straighten fibers, but this requires careful control to avoid melting or damaging the fiber. It is less recommended for beginners due to the risk of overheating .

Industrial and MCVD Tube Straightening

In manufacturing, particularly during Modified Chemical Vapor Deposition (MCVD) for fiber preforms, straightening is critical. After initial deposition, tubes may develop stress or sag. The final straightening process involves stress relief heating, where the headstock end is warmed and the exhaust end is lightly heated while supporting the tube to eliminate sagging. This ensures proper tube alignment and prevents defects like cracks or blocked exhausts .
