

Can multimode OM2 fiber optic cables transmit 10 Gigabit signals

It can transmit up to 550 meters for 1 Gigabit Ethernet and 82 meters for 10 Gigabit Ethernet. With a 500 MHz/km bandwidth, OM2 fiber is commonly used in Local Area Networks (LANs) and private networks for lower-speed Ethernet applications, especially 1 Gigabit Ethernet. How Many Types of Multimode Fiber? Identified by ISO 11801 standard, multimode fiber optic cables can be classified into OM1. If we do 10Gbps speeds, we can reach up to 82 meters on Multi-Mode OM2 cables. The question is - is it possible to achieve a longer distance over OM2 fibre with 10Gbps speed? In theory, yes! 220 meters by using mode conditioning cable and special 10G-LRM (EDGE PN: 10G-SFP-220 optical transceiver):. It was usually used for 100M Ethernet transmission links, but it is capable of transmitting 1G Ethernet up to 275 meters and 10G Ethernet up to 33 meters. The OM2 fiber type of multimode was standardized in 1998. Common applications include Local Area Networks.
