26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. This ensures that when an energized conductor touches the enclosure, the consequential fault current gets low-impedance path to securely conduct to ground.

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Open the distribution box and find the position marked with the grounding plate or PE letter. This position is the connection point of the grounding wire in the box.

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

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Distribution boards (generally only one in residential premises) usually include the meter (s) and in some cases (notably where the supply utilities impose a TT earthing system and/or tariff

Install a ground wire: If your box doesn't already have a ground wire, you need to install one first. One end of the ground wire should be connected to a metal part of the box...

The final element of internal wiring is bonding the metal panel enclosure to the grounding system. This is achieved by installing a main bonding jumper or screw from the dedicated grounding

According to NEC Article 250, neutral and ground wires must remain separate in subpanels. Bonding



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(connecting) the neutral and ground should only occur in the main panel or at the first service
