The channel, trending east-west, is about 150 miles (240 km) long and 3 to 8 miles wide; it separates the archipelago's main island to the north from Navarino, Hoste, and other smaller islands to the south. At its western end the channel splits into two branches that encircle. The Beagle Channel (Spanish: Canal del Beagle; Yahgan: Onasaga) is a strait in the Tierra del Fuego Archipelago, on the extreme southern tip of South America between Chile and Argentina. The Strait of Magellan is further north lying between. To sail Southbound or Northbound from Cape Horn (Cabo de Hornos) to Chacao Channel, there are two main routes; first, the Ocean Route that does not need any special explanation and the Inner Channels Route. Named after the HMS Beagle, the survey ship that carried a young Charles Darwin to these far-flung waters in the 1830s, the channel is one of the world's most.

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Sarmiento Channel is a principal Patagonia channel, which extends in a north-south direction. It begins with the Guila Narrows (Angostura Guaymas) and is located in Magallanes y Antártica Chilena Region.
