

Cold connector fiber optic cable one side higher than the other

Understanding Cold Connectors

Cold connectors, also called fiber optic quick connectors or cold splices, are field-terminated connectors that allow rapid installation without fusion splicing or specialized tools. They contain a pre-polished ceramic ferrule and a mechanical splicing mechanism that aligns the incoming fiber with the factory-installed fiber inside the connector. The mechanical splice typically uses a V-shaped groove and wedge clamp to hold the fiber in place.

Why One Side May Appear Higher

The appearance of one side being higher than the other is often caused by:

- o V-groove alignment: The fiber sits in a V-shaped groove, and the wedge clamp may slightly elevate one side during insertion.
- o Ferrule design: The pre-polished ferrule may protrude slightly to ensure proper contact with the mating connector or adapter.
- o Insertion technique: If the fiber is not fully seated or the wedge clip is not fully removed, one side may appear raised. This is generally normal and does not affect optical performance if the fiber is properly clamped and the connector is fully engaged.

Installation and Troubleshooting Tips

- o Ensure full insertion: Push the fiber into the V-groove until it stops, then remove the wedge clip to lock it in place.
- o Check the ferrule alignment: The ferrule should be flush with the connector housing when fully seated.
- o Inspect with a microscope: Verify that the fiber endface is properly aligned and free of debris. Uneven height is acceptable as long as the optical path is continuous.
- o Test optical performance: Use an optical power meter or OTDR to confirm low insertion loss and minimal back reflection.
