Standard Widths and Guidelines

Communication cable trays are designed to support and organize cables while allowing ventilation and easy access. Standard widths for cable trays vary based on the type of tray and the number of cables to be accommodated. Typical nominal inside widths include 50mm, 100mm, 150mm, 200mm, 300mm, 400mm, 600mm, and up to 900mm for large industrial installations, with the outside width slightly larger due to side rail thickness. Ladder trays, perforated trays, solid-bottom trays, and wire mesh trays all follow these width ranges, but the usable interior width may differ slightly depending on tray design.

Determining the Required Width

The required tray width depends on the total cross-sectional area of the cables and the allowable fill ratio:

- o Ladder trays: Cables can occupy up to 50% of the tray's cross-sectional area for control and signal cables.
- o Solid-bottom trays: Allowable fill is typically 40% to ensure proper ventilation and prevent overheating. To calculate the width:
 - o Measure or obtain the outer diameters of all cables.
 - o Sum the cross-sectional areas of all cables.
 - o Divide by the allowable fill ratio to determine the required tray cross-section.
 - o Divide by the tray height to find the minimum width needed. This ensures adequate space for cable installation, future expansion, and heat dissipation.

Practical Considerations

- o Small installations (e.g., a few data lines) may use trays as narrow as 50mm.
- o Medium installations (e.g., commercial buildings) often use 150-300mm trays.
- o Large industrial or factory setups may require 600-900mm trays.
- o Always leave 40-60% of the tray empty to allow airflow and future cable additions.
- o Consider tray type, material, and thickness, as these affect load capacity and structural support. By following these guidelines, you can select a communication cable tray width that is code-compliant, safe, and future-ready.
