They simplify control and maintenance by localizing circuit management and often include MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers) and protective devices .
3. **Meter Panel** Meter panels house electrical meters to monitor energy consumption. They include primary switches, fuses, and circuits, and are commonly used in residential and commercial buildings to track electricity usage for billing purposes .
4. **Consumer Unit** Consumer units are compact distribution boxes used in homes and small offices. They contain MCBs, RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers), and sometimes surge protection devices. These units ensure safety by interrupting power during faults and organizing circuits efficiently .
5. **Panel Fuse Bank and Unitized Panels** These boxes are designed for specific industrial or commercial applications, providing multiple fuses or breakers in a single enclosure. Unitized panels integrate several functions, such as switching, protection, and metering, into one compact unit .
6. **Transfer Switch and Enclosed Switchgear** Transfer switches allow seamless switching between main power and backup generators. Enclosed switchgear is used in industrial settings to manage high-voltage circuits safely, often including isolators, circuit breakers, and bus bars .
7. **Smart Distribution Boxes** Smart DB boxes integrate advanced features like energy monitoring, remote control, and automation. They are increasingly used in modern residential, commercial, and industrial systems to optimize energy efficiency and enable real-time management .

Classification by Installation and Voltage

- o **1-Phase Distribution Boxes:** Typically for residential use, handling lower loads with fewer circuit breakers .
- o **3-Phase Distribution Boxes:** Designed for commercial and industrial applications, capable of handling larger loads .
- o **Surface-Mounted Boxes:** Installed on walls, suitable for outdoor or industrial environments .
- o **Flush-Mounted Boxes:** Embedded within walls for a cleaner indoor appearance .
- o **Low-Voltage Distribution Boards:** Operate at 400V/690V, common in buildings and industrial plants .

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o Medium-Voltage Enclosures (Ring Main Units): Used in 10kV/12kV cable networks, fully sealed and maintenance-free for city or utility power distribution .

Most distribution boxes include:

- o Circuit Breakers: Protect circuits from overloads and short circuits.
- o Residual Current Circuit Breakers (RCCBs): Detect imbalances to prevent electric shocks.
- o Isolators: Allow safe maintenance by disconnecting parts of the circuit.
- o Bus Bars and Terminals: Facilitate organized power distribution.
- o Indication Lights and Meters: Provide visual status and energy monitoring .
