Grounding Bus Bar: Directs excess current safely into the ground during faults, preventing shocks and fire hazards .

Surge Protective Device (SPD): Protects the electrical system from sudden voltage spikes caused by lightning or faults between phases .

Indication Lights: Visual indicators show the status of the main power supply, allowing quick checks of electricity availability .

Electrical Wiring: Includes internal wiring connecting all components and may also accommodate connections for solar panels or other equipment .

Enclosure: The outer casing, typically made from durable materials like polycarbonate (PC), Acrylonitrile Styrene Acrylate (ASA), or epoxy-coated stainless steel, protects internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage .
