**Circuit Breakers:** Protect individual circuits by automatically cutting off power during overloads or short circuits, preventing damage to wiring and connected devices . **Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB):** Detects small imbalances in current to prevent electric shocks, often used alongside circuit breakers for enhanced safety . **Isolators:** Manually operated switches that allow safe disconnection of circuits for maintenance, reducing the risk of electric shock . **Bus Bars:** Metal strips that conduct electricity within the box, serving as central connection points for multiple circuits . **Neutral Link:** Provides a return path for electrical current, ensuring proper circuit operation . **Grounding Bus Bar:** Directs excess current safely into the ground during faults, preventing shocks and fire hazards . **Enclosure:** The outer casing, typically made of polycarbonate, ASA, or epoxy-coated stainless steel, protects internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage . **Electrical Wiring:** Connects circuits and devices, often protected by miniature circuit breakers (MCBs) or fuses . **Surge Protective Device (SPD):** Shields the system from voltage spikes caused by lightning or phase faults . **Indication Lights:** Provide visual status of the main power supply, allowing quick monitoring of system operation .
