



# Connect the cable tray to the bottom of the cable tray at a 45-degree angle

## Preview

Simply make the appropriate cuts in the side wall of the tray you are joining a length to, bend down the side wall, and attach a TX bracket either side. Riser links must always be installed in pairs, one on each side of the tray. Connecting cable trays correctly is essential for system safety, load stability, and long-term performance.
