

Connect the power cord to the distribution box for power

Article Overview

To connect a power cord to a distribution box, attach the incoming live (phase) and neutral wires to the main MCB, connect the earth wire to the earth link, and then distribute power to the circuit breakers safely.

Step-by-Step Connection Process

1. Safety First

- o Ensure the main power supply is turned off before starting any work.
- o Use insulated tools and wear protective gear to prevent electrical shock.

2. Prepare the Distribution Box

- o Secure the distribution box to a wall at an accessible height.
- o Identify the main input terminals, circuit breaker slots, neutral busbar, and earth link.

3. Connect the Incoming Power Cord

- o Live (Phase) Wire: Connect the live wire (usually brown or red) from the power cord to the input terminal of the main double-pole MCB.
- o Neutral Wire: Connect the neutral wire (usually blue or black) to the neutral busbar or the input of the RCCB if present.
- o Earth Wire: Connect the earth wire (green/yellow) to the earth link in the distribution box. Ensure the metallic body of the box is also earthed if it is metal.

4. Connect Circuit Breakers

- o Insert the MCBs (single-pole or double-pole) into their designated slots.
- o Connect the phase wire from the main MCB or RCCB output to the input of each circuit breaker.
- o Connect the neutral wire from the RCCB output to the neutral busbar for single-pole MCBs.
- o Connect the earth wire from each load to the earth link.

5. Connect Outgoing Loads

- o For each load (lights, fans, appliances), connect the phase wire to the output terminal of the corresponding MCB, the neutral wire to the neutral busbar, and the earth wire to the earth link.



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6. Verification

- o Use a multimeter to check for proper voltage and ensure there are no short circuits.
- o Double-check that all connections are tight and correctly labeled for safety and future maintenance.

7. Final Safety Check

- o Ensure all exposed wires are insulated.
- o Confirm that the distribution box is properly closed and secured.
- o Turn on the main power supply and test each circuit individually.
