

Connection of wires to the distribution box

Article Overview

In a distribution box, the main supply wires connect to the main MCB, which then feeds the RCCB and individual circuit breakers, with neutral and earth wires routed to their respective links for safe distribution.

Main Components and Their Roles

- o Main MCB (Double Pole): Acts as the main switch, receiving the incoming phase (live) and neutral wires from the power supply .
- o RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker): Provides protection against leakage currents and ensures safety for all connected circuits .
- o Single Pole MCBs: Protect individual circuits, typically for lighting or small appliances .
- o Double Pole MCBs: Used for high-power loads, connecting both phase and neutral .
- o Neutral Link: A busbar where all neutral wires from circuits are connected .
- o Earth Link: A busbar connecting all earth wires, including the metallic body of the box and the earth pit wire .

Step-by-Step Wiring Connections

- o Incoming Supply: Connect the live (phase) and neutral wires from the main power supply to the input terminals of the main MCB .
- o Main MCB to RCCB: Connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB. This ensures all downstream circuits are protected .
- o RCCB to Load MCBs:
 - o For single pole MCBs, connect only the phase wire from the RCCB output to the MCB input. The neutral wire goes to the neutral link .
 - o For double pole MCBs, connect both phase and neutral wires from the RCCB output to the MCB input .
- o Connecting Loads:
 - o For SP MCBs, connect the phase terminal of the load to the MCB output, and the neutral and earth wires to the neutral and earth links respectively .
 - o For DP MCBs, connect both phase and neutral terminals of the load to the MCB output, and the earth wire to the earth link .
- o Earth Connections: Connect the earth wire from the supply or earth pit to the earth link, and also bond the metallic body of the distribution box to this link for safety .
- o Verification: After wiring, use a multimeter to check for proper connections, continuity, and absence of short circuits .

Safety Tips

- o Always turn off the main supply before working inside the distribution box.
- o Ensure all wires are properly insulated and securely tightened to prevent loose connections .
- o Use appropriately rated MCBs and RCCBs according to the load requirements .
- o Clearly label each circuit to identify which MCB controls which load . By following this sequence, electricity is safely distributed from the main supply to individual circuits, with protection against overloads, short circuits, and leakage currents.
