

Correct wiring method at the top of the distribution box

Incoming Power Connections

- o Securing Wires: Use cable ties or clamps to hold wires in place, preventing movement that could loosen connections over time .

Safety and Verification

- o Power Off: Always ensure the main power is turned off before making connections .
- o Testing: After wiring, use a multimeter or insulation resistance tester to verify proper connections, continuity, and insulation resistance .
- o Breaker Placement: Position circuit breakers in their slots and connect branch circuit wires according to the load requirements, ensuring each circuit has its own protection .

- o Labeling: Clearly label all wires and breakers for easy identification during maintenance or troubleshooting .
- o Compliance: Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use certified components

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(UL/CE) to ensure safety and reliability .

o Heat Dissipation: Leave adequate space around wires and components to prevent overheating, especially near the top where incoming power enters .
