

Cost of fabricating cable trays

Article Overview

The cost to fabricate cable trays ranges from approximately \$2 to \$25 per meter, depending on material, type, size, and surface finish, with labor, equipment, and shipping adding to the total cost.

Material Costs

Cable tray fabrication costs are heavily influenced by the material used :

- o Galvanized Steel: Most common, balances durability and cost.
- o Stainless Steel: High corrosion resistance, more expensive, used in hygienic or coastal environments.
- o Aluminum: Lightweight and rust-proof, moderately expensive, reduces support structure costs.
- o Plastic/Polymer: Budget-friendly, suitable for light loads, not ideal for heavy industrial cables. Surface coatings also affect cost:

- o Powder Coating: Protects against wear, available in multiple colors.

Tray Type

- o Ladder Trays: Strong, support heavy cables, higher fabrication cost.
- o Wire Mesh/Perforated Trays: Cheaper, suitable for lighter cables, faster to install.

Labor and Fabrication Costs

Labor is a significant factor in fabrication:

- o Skilled workers are required for cutting, welding, and finishing .
- o Equipment depreciation and energy consumption (welding, cutting, surface finishing) contribute to overall cost.
- o Installation is faster than conduit systems, potentially saving 40-60% of total project labor costs .

Manufacturing Plant Considerations

For large-scale production, setting up a metal cable tray manufacturing plant involves:
