Global optical cable projects are rapidly expanding, with submarine and terrestrial fiber networks growing to support 5G, cloud, AI, and smart city initiatives, though regional challenges persist.

Submarine Cable Projects

The global undersea cable network has seen significant activity, with over 70 projects in 2025 including new deployments, upgrades, and feasibility studies . Key trends include:

- o Hyperscale and long-haul systems designed for cloud and AI traffic, with ultra-high-capacity, terabit-scale fiber counts .
- o Strategic routing through the Arctic, Red Sea, Mediterranean, Pacific, and Indian Ocean to enhance redundancy and geopolitical resilience .
- o Major hubs such as Marseille, Singapore, Oman, Egypt, Japan, and Florida continue to consolidate as global connectivity gateways .
- o Notable milestones include the completion of the 2Africa system, spanning 45,000 km and setting a benchmark for open-access global connectivity . Terrestrial Fiber-Optic Expansion

The terrestrial fiber-optic market is also growing rapidly, driven by 5G rollout, data center proliferation, and smart city projects . Key points include:

- o The global fiber-optic cable market was valued at USD 13 billion in 2024 and is projected to reach USD 34.5 billion by 2034, growing at a CAGR of 10.4% .
- o Single-mode fiber dominates the market due to its efficiency over long distances, accounting for USD 7.26 billion in 2024 .
- o Fiber is critical for 5G backhaul and fronthaul, supporting high-speed, low-latency connectivity for small cell networks .
- o IoT integration and smart city development are driving demand for high-speed, secure, and reliable fiber networks .

Regional Challenges

Despite global growth, some regions face significant hurdles:

- o In Germany, only 23% of households were connected to fiber networks by mid-2024, with just 11% having active subscriptions .
- o Challenges include complex approval procedures, high construction costs, skilled labor shortages, and regional competition .
- o Accelerating fiber rollout requires streamlined regulations, collaboration with contractors, and investment in civil engineering capacity .

The optical cable sector is poised for continued expansion, with submarine cables enhancing global connectivity and terrestrial fiber supporting 5G, cloud, and smart infrastructure. Innovations in high-capacity, low-latency fiber technology will be critical to meet rising data demands, while addressing regulatory and logistical challenges will determine the pace of regional deployments .
