o Boxes must allow for organized routing of cables and secure attachment of protective devices.

o Many CSN standards are harmonized with EN (European Norms), ensuring that distribution boxes meet EU safety and interoperability requirements .

o This includes compatibility with standard circuit breakers, residual current devices (RCDs), and modular components.

o Installation and Maintenance
