The connection status of a Digital Wiring Unit depends on proper wiring, addressing, and power sequencing, with each unit correctly recognized on the RS485 bus.

Understanding Digital Input Unit Connections

Digital Input Units (DIUs) can be connected using either dry (voltage-free) or wet (voltage) inputs. Dry inputs are connected to D.GND and DI 0-DI 15, and can be Normally Open (NO) or Normally Closed (NC). Wet inputs operate at logic levels, with 0 = 3 V or less and 1 = 10-50 V, connected to DI COM and DI 0-DI 15 . Each DIU communicates over an RS485 bus, and multiple units can be daisy-chained, but each must have a unique address to avoid conflicts .

Initial Setup and Power Sequencing

To ensure proper connection status:

- o Configure the Nimbus system with the protocol set as ADAM Module and assign a new Connect/Fixed Gateway.
- o Add and configure each DIU in the system, specifying the number of inputs and their addresses.
- o Power on the units in sequence: first the DIU, then the Connect/Fixed Gateway. The gateway scans the network and registers all connected units .
- o Verify registration: If a unit fails to register, technical support may be required to troubleshoot addressing or wiring issues .

Troubleshooting Connection Status

- o Check wiring integrity: Ensure all RS485 connections (Tx/Rx and ground) are correctly mapped and that power is properly distributed.
- o LED indicators: Many DIUs and PLCs have LEDs showing input status. An input LED that does not illuminate may indicate a wiring fault, incorrect voltage, or a misconfigured address .
- o Configuration spreadsheet: Each input is defined in a spreadsheet uploaded to the Nimbus Web Portal, similar to fire alarm panel configuration. Ensure the spreadsheet matches the physical wiring .

Best Practices

- o Avoid daisy-chaining power directly between units; use a terminal block for proper distribution .
- o Ensure each unit has a unique address on the RS485 bus to prevent communication conflicts .
- o Follow electrical safety procedures when wiring or powering units, especially when integrating with PLCs or other industrial equipment . By following these steps, the connection status of each Digital Wiring Unit can
