The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Cable trays are used for supporting, enclosing, and completely installed, without damage either to conductors or structural system use maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is bent the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when.
