Immediate Inspection

After rainfall, check the distribution box for visible water, condensation, or leaks. Ensure that the lid or cover is properly closed and that gaskets or seals are intact, especially if the box is rated IP65 or higher .

Preventive Measures

- o Use waterproof or weatherproof enclosures with IP65-IP68 ratings for outdoor installations .
- o Ensure UV-stabilized and corrosion-resistant materials like ABS, polycarbonate, aluminum, or stainless steel are used .
- o Install proper gaskets, weatherproof cable glands, and vents to prevent water ingress while allowing air circulation .
- o Maintain sloped roofs or drainage holes to divert rainwater away from the box .
- o Keep the area around the box clean and free of debris to prevent water pooling and rust .
- o Schedule regular inspections, ideally twice a year, to check seals, hinges, and internal components .

Maintenance After Rain

- o Dry the interior if any moisture is detected, using a dry cloth or desiccant packs .
- o Tighten or replace worn seals and gaskets to restore waterproof integrity .
- o Check wiring and terminals for corrosion or damage and replace any compromised components .
