Common Causes of Power Off

- o **Earth Leakage or Safety Devices:** Modern distribution boxes often include Earth Leakage Circuit Breakers (ELCBs) or Residual Current Devices (RCDs) that cut power instantly if a current imbalance is detected, protecting against electric shock .
- o **Overdrawn Power Sources:** In systems powered by solar or backup sources, excessive draw can deplete the supply, causing the distribution box to shut off connected devices .

Troubleshooting Steps

- o **Check the Main Switch:** Ensure the main switch in the distribution box is on. This switch can cut off power to the entire property for maintenance or emergencies .
- o **Inspect Circuit Breakers and Fuses:** Identify any tripped breakers or blown fuses and reset or replace them as needed .
- o **Measure Voltage:** Use a multimeter to check voltage at the power source and at the end of supply wires. A significant drop indicates wiring issues or insufficient supply .
- o **Examine Connections:** Verify that all wires are properly secured in terminals and that insulation is not interfering with contact .
- o **Test with Alternative Power:** If a device or sensor is unpowered, test it with a separate power source to confirm it is functioning .

Safety Considerations

- o Always turn off the main power before inspecting or working inside a distribution box.
- o Use insulated tools and wear protective equipment to prevent electric shock.
- o Avoid overloading circuits and ensure the power supply matches the system's startup and operational requirements . By following these steps, you can identify why a distribution box has powered off and take
