Unlike traditional pluggable optics, which require long electrical paths from the ASIC to the transceiver, CPO places optical components around the ASIC, achieving millimeter-level electrical connections through silicon photonics interfaces. This integration reduces power loss, improves signal integrity, lowers overall power consumption, and frees up front-panel space, making it ideal for high-bandwidth industrial applications and AI-driven automation networks.
