- o Gigabit Ethernet WAN port to connect to the ONT
 - o High-speed Wi-Fi standards (Wi-Fi 5, Wi-Fi 6, or Wi-Fi 6E) to fully utilize fiber speeds
 - o Multi-gigabit Ethernet ports if your plan exceeds 1 Gbps
 - o Low latency and Quality of Service (QoS) for gaming, video conferencing, or multiple device management
- Older routers designed for DSL or cable may not support fiber speeds or the required WAN connection type, potentially limiting your internet performance .
