

Does Tuvalu have ADS fiber optic cable

Article Overview

Tuvalu does not have an ADS (Aerial Delivery System) fiber optic cable; its international connectivity is provided by the Tuvalu Vaka submarine cable.

Tuvalu's first international fiber optic connection is the Tuvalu Vaka Cable, which links Funafuti, the capital, to the Bulikula cable system, part of Google's Pacific Connect initiative . This submarine cable contains four fiber pairs and was fully operational by 2025, providing high-speed internet and improved digital connectivity across the islands . The project was funded entirely through grants from the US, Australia, New Zealand, and Taiwan, with Australia contributing up to USD 37 million . The Vaka Cable complements other initiatives such as Starlink community gateways, which provide redundancy and enhance internet access in Tuvalu . The rollout of Fibre to the Premises (FTTP) in Funafuti has further expanded high-speed internet availability for residents . Currently, Tuvalu's telecommunications infrastructure is managed by the Tuvalu Telecommunications Corporation (TTC), which oversees both domestic services and the operation of the Vaka submarine cable . Plans for additional regional connectivity, such as the Central Pacific Cable project, aim to further integrate Tuvalu into the broader Pacific fiber network . In summary, Tuvalu relies on submarine fiber optic cables rather than aerial fiber systems like ADS, marking a significant step in improving internet speed, reliability, and access for its population .
