They are not intended for permanent splicing, which is better handled by fusion splicing or pigtails for long-term, low-loss connections .

- o **Insertion Loss:** Each connection introduces a small loss, so multiple patch cords in series can degrade signal quality.
- o **Twist and Polarity:** When connecting duplex fibers, ensure proper TX-to-RX alignment to maintain correct signal flow .
- o **Flexibility:** Patch cords allow easy maintenance, upgrades, or rerouting without disturbing the main fiber infrastructure .
