Electricity enters the box from the main power line. Inside the box, the power is split into multiple circuits --each one leading to a different area, like your kitchen, workshop, or machine line. Circuit breakers, fuses, or other safety devices monitor the flow. Core idea: Distribution lines are the local electric circuits that carry power from distribution substations to customer service areas. What controls it: Feeder. At the heart of this network lies a power distribution box, the component responsible for dividing and controlling electricity as it moves from the main source to multiple end-use circuits. It contains safety mechanisms like circuit breakers, neutral and ground bars, and wiring. Wires lead off from the neighbourhood's power lines and connect to individual buildings (homes, apartments, businesses, etc) by first going through the electric meter to measure how much electricity the home uses.
