Preparation and Material Check

Before starting, ensure the installation site is dry, ventilated, and accessible, away from flammable or corrosive substances . Prepare all necessary tools such as screwdrivers, wire strippers, multimeters, and insulation testers, and verify that they are in good condition . Installation of the Box

Mount the distribution box securely on a stable surface using expansion bolts or appropriate mounting hardware, ensuring it is level and firmly fixed . For double-layer boxes, ensure the upper and lower layers are accessible for wiring and future maintenance. Leave sufficient space for ventilation and heat dissipation.

Circuit Breaker Arrangement

Arrange circuit breakers from left to right, with reserved positions typically on the right side . Install independent breakers according to the electrical load requirements, ensuring each circuit has its own protection device . For double-layer boxes, distribute circuits logically between layers to facilitate maintenance and reduce wire congestion.

Wire Preparation and Connection

- o Strip insulation from wires, leaving an appropriate length of exposed conductor .
- o Follow color coding standards: blue for neutral, yellow/green/red for phases A/B/C .
- o Connect wires to terminals: line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground, using screws or terminal clamps .
- o Route wires neatly within the enclosure, securing them with cable ties and leaving space for heat dissipation .
- o For double-layer boxes, ensure wiring between layers is organized, with main circuit connections typically on the left and outgoing circuits on the right .

Labeling and Safety Checks

Label each circuit clearly to facilitate future maintenance and troubleshooting . Conduct insulation resistance tests and verify that all connections meet required standards . Ensure that the main switch, breakers, and protective devices function correctly before powering on . Operators should wear insulating gloves, safety glasses, and slip-resistant shoes during installation .

After wiring, perform a visual inspection to check for loose connections, proper wire routing, and absence of short circuits or overload risks . Document the installation with circuit labeling and as-built drawings for future reference . Schedule regular maintenance and inspections to ensure long-term reliability and safety .
