Drop cable termination splicing trays are specialized enclosures that organize, protect, and manage fiber splices for FTTP and aerial fiber networks.

Overview

A drop cable termination splicing tray is a component within a fiber optic closure or terminal box that allows for secure splicing and termination of drop cables. These trays protect the fiber splices from environmental damage, mechanical stress, and contamination while providing organized storage for fiber slack and pigtails .

Types and Applications

- o Aerial Fiber Terminal Closures: Examples include the SLiC 530 and FLK-AFAT-328 closures. These closures separate the distribution cable splice chamber from the drop termination chamber, allowing installers to terminate drop cables without disturbing the main splice area . They are suitable for aerial, pole, wall, or manhole installations.
- o Indoor Termination Boxes: The CCP Series and FBR Series are designed for indoor use, integrating splicing, splitting, and distribution in one unit. They typically support SC or LC adapters and are used in wall-mounted or patch panel configurations .

Splice Tray Features

- o Capacity: Common trays accommodate 12 fibers per tray, with closures holding multiple trays for higher capacities (e.g., 3 trays for 36 fibers in the FLK-AFAT-328), .
- o Material: High-quality polycarbonate, ABS, or modified PP materials are used for durability, UV resistance, and corrosion protection .
- o Protection: Trays and closures often include mechanical seals, silicon rubber rings, or clip locks to prevent moisture ingress and maintain fiber integrity .
- o Connector Integration: Some trays support pre-terminated drop cables with SC or LC connectors, reducing field splicing and contamination risk .

Installation Considerations

- o Separation of Chambers: Closures with separate splice and drop chambers simplify maintenance and reduce the risk of disturbing existing splices .
- o Splicing Methods: Trays support fusion or mechanical splicing, with organized routing for buffer tubes or ribbons.
- o Environmental Suitability: Outdoor closures are designed for aerial, buried, or pole-mounted applications,

while indoor boxes are optimized for wall-mounted or patch panel setups .
