Overview of QSFP Technology

QSFP (Quad Small Form-Factor Pluggable) transceivers are hot-pluggable optical modules that combine four independent electrical channels into a single compact form factor, allowing scalable bandwidth from 40 Gbps to 1.6 Tbps across successive generations . Key QSFP types include:

- o QSFP+: 4x10 Gbps channels, total 40 Gbps, ideal for high-density switch and router ports .
- o QSFP28: 4x25 Gbps channels, total 100 Gbps, widely used in 100 Gigabit Ethernet deployments .
