These tubes shrink when exposed to heat, forming a tight seal around the fiber splice to prevent damage and maintain signal integrity .

Construction and Materials

- o Cross-linked polyolefin: Provides flexibility, durability, and heat shrink capability .
- o Hot fusion adhesive liner: Ensures a secure bond around the fiber splice and seals against moisture .
- o Reinforcing rod: Made of stainless steel, quartz, or ceramic, this rod adds mechanical strength to the splice area and prevents fiber breakage . Some designs include a clear sleeve for easy visual inspection of the splice before shrinking .

Types

- o Single fiber tubing: Designed for individual fiber splices.
- o Ribbon fiber tubing: Accommodates multiple fibers in a ribbon configuration.
- o Medium-wall tubing: Used in fiber optic splice closures for outdoor or harsh environments, often with a polyamide hot-melt adhesive for watertight and gastight sealing .
