To configure a router and fiber optic switch, first connect the fiber line to an ONT, link it to your router, then access the router and switch settings to set up IPs, VLANs, and security.

Connecting Fiber Optic Internet to a Router

- o **Gather Equipment:** You will need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP, a fiber-ready router, fiber optic cables (SC/APC or SC/UPC), and Ethernet cables (Cat 6 or higher) for connection .
- o **Install the ONT:** Locate the fiber wall outlet, connect the fiber optic cable from the wall to the ONT, and power it on. Wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating the ONT is ready .

- o **Optimize Performance:** Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you use VoIP or video conferencing, and verify all cables are securely connected. Run a speed test to ensure proper connectivity .

- o **VLAN and Port Configuration:** Set up VLANs according to your network plan. Use commands like show vtp status to verify Virtual Trunking Protocol (VTP) settings and ensure the switch updates VLANs correctly from neighboring switches .
- o **Security and Testing:** Assign access ports, configure trunk ports if needed, and test connectivity between devices. Ensure only authorized devices can access the network and monitor switch logs for errors .

- o Use high-quality Ethernet cables to maintain gigabit speeds.
- o Regularly update router and switch firmware for security and performance.
