A fiber optic box, or Optical Network Terminal (ONT), connects your fiber internet to a router, and can be paired with a storage or wall-mounted enclosure for neat organization and optimal performance.

What a Fiber Optic Box (ONT) Does

A fiber optic box, commonly called an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), is installed by your ISP to convert light signals from the fiber line into electrical signals that your router can use . It typically connects to your router via an Ethernet cable, allowing your wireless router to distribute internet throughout your home . Some ISPs provide a combined ONT and router unit, but many setups use separate devices for flexibility and better performance .

Connecting Fiber to Your Router

- o Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP fiber line enters your home.
- o Connect the fiber cable to the ONT's designated port.
- o Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize.
- o Link the ONT to your router using a high-speed Ethernet cable (CAT6 or better).
- o Configure your router via its admin panel, entering ISP credentials if required, and update firmware for optimal performance . Routers compatible with fiber often have SFP or WAN ports labeled for fiber and support high-speed standards like Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 for multi-gigabit connections .
