Fiber optic cable costs range from \$0.09 to \$6 per foot for materials, with total installation costs varying widely depending on cable type, fiber count, and connection method.

Material Costs

The price of fiber optic cable depends on the type and number of fibers:

- o Single-mode fiber: \$0.10-\$0.50 per foot for the cable itself, cheaper than multimode but requires more expensive equipment for connections .
- o Multimode fiber: \$0.30-\$1.00 per foot, with OM5 being ~25% higher than OM4 .

Installation Costs

The total cost of connecting fiber optic cable depends on the installation method and project scope:

- o Indoor plenum or riser runs: \$0.80-\$1.70 per foot, including fire-rated pathways .
- o Aerial installation (utility poles): \$1.20-\$2.50 per foot, requiring permits .
- o Open trench (lawn/field): \$0.90-\$1.80 per foot, fastest and lowest cost .
- o Directional boring (road crossings): \$3.00-\$7.00 per foot, avoids surface disruption .
- o Home installations: \$1,500-\$7,000 total, averaging \$4,500 for typical residential projects, depending on cable length, labor, and connection points . Commercial installations with 100-200 network drops can range from \$15,000 to \$30,000, while underground projects may cost \$5,000-\$20,000 per mile and aerial installations \$40,000-\$60,000 per mile .

Factors Affecting Price

- o Fiber count: More strands increase cost proportionally.
- o Cable construction: Armored, plenum-rated, or low-smoke zero-halogen (LSZH) cables cost more.
- o Connection type: Pre-terminated connectors are more expensive than field splicing.
- o Installation environment: Underground or harsh environments increase labor and material costs.
- o Bulk purchasing: Buying longer reels (e.g., 10,000 ft) can reduce per-foot cost by ~20% .
